

**Code of Ethics for Avoiding Plagiarism**

- Plagiarism can be avoided by citing the work of others during assignments, reports, synopsis or thesis submission.
- Use of material, ideas, figures, or data without appropriately acknowledging the original source shall be considered as plagiarism.
- Copying without acknowledgment from an unpublished manuscript shall also be considered as plagiarism.
- Reproducing, a part or whole text/sentences from a report or book or thesis or publication
- Reproducing else's or one's previously published data, illustrations, figures, images etc.
- Copying verbatim from one's own earlier published work in a journal or conference proceedings without appropriate citations shall be considered as self plagiarism
- Paraphrasing without citation
- To avoid plagiarism and follow code of ethics, students and faculty can use the online plagiarism checking tools or the subscribed software available with Central Library, SGB Amravati University
- Submitting the reports, dissertation, assignments and thesis, student needs to submit the certificate that the work is original and not plagiarized from any source.
